Young Urology Trainee's Scholarship Training Fund Regulations

To encourage young urology trainees to attend conference/workshops to enhance their professional knowledge, skills and competencies, the “HKUA Young Urology Trainee’s Scholarship Training Fund” was set up under the following regulations,

1. The fund will be granted to 5 pre-fellows (January to December each year), 5 young fellows within 10 years of passing fellowship examination (January to December each year).
2. Only one scholarship would be offered for each applicant within a financial year (1 January to 31 December)
3. The applicant cannot file another application within 6 months after an event supported by this scholarship.
4. Those who haven’t received the fund in each year have priority over those who have received the fund.
5. The amount of the fund will be allocated according to the location and participation of the applicant as follows,

\$6,000	Attend meetings in Asia without abstract presentation
\$8,000	Attend meetings in Asia with abstract presentation
\$15,000	Attend meetings outside Asia without abstract presentation
\$20,000	Attend meetings outside Asia with abstract presentation
6. The applicant has to attend at least more than 60% of the HKUA CME/CNE monthly meeting as documented on the attendance record in the last 12 months.
7. All successful applicants are requested to deliver a 5-min presentation on the course/meeting about the knowledge they learned or the paper they presented, on the subsequent HKUA CME/CNE monthly meeting upon request.
8. The HKUA council has the final decision and approval on each application, not limited to the number of applicant receiving the fund in each year or the amount receiving by the applicant for each meeting.
